Mrs Tagg advised the purpose of the report is to provide an overview of key issues across the Southland District, as well as high level local issues from various Council units.

Mrs Tagg informed the report highlighted various issues of interest including;

- Harvesting is now completed in Ohai and whilst log prices are slightly back for export in April it is still well up on budget
- LED streetlight replacement work is currently underway in Nightcaps

Mrs Tagg advised the Southland Building and Preservation Trust have responded to a request by the Subcommittee to investigate locating the restored historic dray to the rear of the Sinclair Miners Cottage site and have requested that a one page proposal, including photos, be forwarded to the Trust for consideration.
