- A car had left the road on a corner on Woodlands South Road and that there
 is a need for the yellow chevrons to indicate the corner
- Problems with cars speeding through Woodlands only Woodlands Morton Mains Road
- War memorial board on a wall at the Woodlands school requires a new home and an approach has been made to a local resident to facilitate a new location
