7.1 Unbudgeted Expenditure - Dipton Hall Window Replacement

Community Facilities Manager – Mark Day was in attendance for this item.

Mr Day advised that the purpose of the report was for the Subcommittee to be informed about the cost to replace the windows at the Dipton Hall and to approve the additional unbudgeted expenditure to complete the project.

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The Subcommittee decided that it would prefer double glazing installed not single glazing. They acknowledged that the cost of completing the window replacement would increase.

That the Dipton Community Development Area Subcommittee:

- b) Determines that this matter or decision be recognised as not significant in terms of Section 76 of the Local Government Act 2002.
- c) Determines that it has complied with the decision-making provisions of the Local Government Act 2002 to the extent necessary in relation to this decision; and in accordance with Section 79 of the Act determines that it does not require further information, further assessment of options or further analysis of costs and benefits or advantages and disadvantages prior to making a decision on this matter.
- d) Approves unbudgeted expenditure of \$12,037.23 \$5,000.00 for the installation of <u>double glazed</u> aluminium windows at the Dipton Hall to be funded from the Dipton General Reserve.

New e) Notes that the total amount quoted will rise to \$47,037.23.
