7.3 Unbudgeted Expenditure - Dr Woods Memorial Playground

Community facilities contract manager – Angie Hopkinson was in attendance for this item.

Mrs Hopkinson advised that the purpose of the report was to recommend to Council the unbudgeted expenditure of \$36,140.54 which is to be joint funded from the Nightcaps general reserve (\$14,887.00) and a loan (\$21,253.54).

The Board noted that while the officers report was requesting approval for a recommendation to Council for unbudgeted expenditure of \$36,140.54 which was to be joint funded from the Nightcaps general reserve (\$14,887.00) and a loan (\$21,253.54).
